

# WELCOME WAREHOUSE 2020 COMMUNITY IMPACT

OVER 3,000 PEOPLE RECEIVED ASSISTANCE FROM WELCOME WAREHOUSE AND 278 PEOPLE BENEFITTED FROM REFERRALS TO COMMUNITY PARTNERS FOR ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

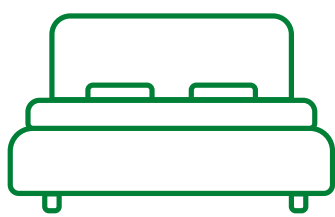


## EMERGENCY HOUSEHOLD ASSISTANCE

Helps families facing a financial crisis pay utility bills, medical needs, transportation costs and food assistance. Welcome Warehouse distributed nearly **\$30,000** in financial assistance in 2020. This is a **60.5%** increase from the previous year.

## CLOTHING FREE SHOP

Offers gently used clothing, small household items and personal care items to families in need. In 2020, over **11,704** clothing, household and personal care items were distributed to families in the Dublin Community despite having to close **9 times** during the pandemic. **1,139** people received items from the clothing free shop. This includes **543** people from **111** unique families.



## BED DONATION PROGRAM

Provides mattresses and bedding to those in need because every person deserves a clean, comfortable bed to sleep on. **288** mattresses and bedroom items were donated to **40** families in 2020.

## BACK-TO-SCHOOL OUTREACH

Provides free backpacks and school supplies for students in need so students can start the school year off prepared. **575** students received backpacks filled with school supplies for the 2020-21 school year. This is a **10%** increase from the previous year.



## ADOPT-A-FAMILY HOLIDAY PROGRAM

Gives children the gift of joy of receiving holiday presents. Each child receives up to \$100 worth of gifts and families receive a \$50 grocery gift card towards a holiday meal. **594** children and **213** families received gifts during the 2020 holiday season. This is a **28%** increase in children receiving gifts in 2020 compared to 2019.

## DUBLIN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PROFILE

- **16%** of Dublin Students (more than **2,600** children) are considered economically disadvantaged
- **21%** of the population speaks a native language other than English
- **19%** of female-headed families with children live below the poverty level
- **4,700** households live on less than **\$35,000** annually

## IMPACT FROM OUR COMMUNITY AND PARTNERS

- Approximately **\$224,600** of in-kind donations passed through Welcome Warehouse in 2020
- **230** volunteers contributed over **1,800** hours of support despite the pandemic.
- Over **80** community partners helped fulfill our mission
- Partnered with Finding Hope Center to provide mattresses and bedding to their furniture bank
